



Clarkston Education Foundation Manufacturing Scholarship

This scholarship is open to any current year graduating senior at Clarkston High School who meets the following criteria. The intended purpose of this scholarship is to target students who desire to go into a secondary education program that will provide an education in some sort of manufacturing process. This would include: machine tool operation (machinist), machine tool programming (CNC machinist), welding and fabrication of metal, and drafting or computer aided drafting, such as SolidWorks training. Fields of study that would *not* qualify for this scholarship are vocational training in diesel or automotive mechanics and/or automotive body repair. To be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must have at least a cumulative C average (2.0) and a good attendance record. Involvement in extracurricular activities such as Technical Clubs, FFA, or Sports is a plus, but not a requirement. This scholarship is a onetime award of **\$500.00** to be awarded when selected applicant has provided proof of college registration. You may be called for a personal interview.
