The Clarkston Education Foundation (CEF) was established in 2002 with the purpose of enhancing education in Clarkston schools. We value education and we want to make an investment in your future. The funding for this scholarship is provided by the friends and family of Brent McGreer, a 2003 CHS graduate who was active in DECA and FCCLA leadership. Selection is based on academic achievement, extracurricular activity, and leadership. Eligibility is based on involvement within FCCLA and DECA.

Thank you for requesting a scholarship from the Clarkston Education Foundation. Scholarship recipients may pursue two-year or four-year courses of instruction leading to a bachelor's degree, professional or technical degree, or any other course of instruction meeting the approval of the CEF Board of Directors.

Please be sure that you have a complete packet that includes a three-page application, an advisor evaluation form, a teacher evaluation form and a guidance counselor evaluation form.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Applications must be received by the Clarkston Education Foundation by April 1, (not postmarked by that date). Send completed applications to:

A completed scholarship application includes:

1. **The Application Form.** Answer all questions on the application. Check to see that all the blanks have been completed with either the information or N/A (not applicable).
2. **The Advisor Evaluation**, sealed in a confidential envelope. This should be completed by an advisor who works with you in a leadership role.
3. **The Teacher Evaluation**, sealed in a confidential envelope.
4. **The Guidance Counselor Evaluation**, sealed in a confidential envelope.
5. **Official School Transcript** showing your cumulative GPA.

AWARDS: Award recipients will be announced in early May. Written notification will be sent to all applicants by May 15. Upon confirmation of full-time status, payments will be made to the recipient's educational institution in equal payments. Recipients are required to furnish CEF any information requested.
